PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT- 1910.132

- 1. Personal protective equipment (PPE) must be provided, used, and maintained in a sanitary and reliable condition to protect workers from health and safety hazards.
- 2. Employers must ensure that employee-owned equipment is adequate and maintained in a sanitary and reliable condition.
- 3. All PPE must be designed and constructed safely to reduce the possibility of injury. Damaged equipment should never be used.
- 4. Employees must identify hazards (actual or potential) in the workplace.
- 5. Employers must select the proper PPE for those hazards and provide employees with the knowledge and training to properly wear PPE. Employees would be trained on:
 - · When PPE is necessary
 - What PPE is necessary
 - How to use PPE
 - Limitations of PPE
 - Proper care, maintenance, useful life, and disposal of PPE
- 6. Employees must make sure that affected employees wear PPE.
- 7. There must be written certification signed and dated indicating that the hazard assessment has been performed.
